

Uploading your materials onto the Citizen Rights student space

Uploading materials is simple: just follow the steps below.


Step 1

Go to the Citizen Rights website (citizenrights.euroalter.com) and click on 'Log in' to log in to the Student Space using the username and password given to your class. If you don't have one or need a new password, write to citizenrights@euroalter.com and we'll give you a new one.

Step 2

You are now on a screen called 'Write a new blog post'. Here you can upload your material and share it with the Citizen Rights community.

You just need to give the blog post a:

- Title
- Confirm you are not a robot – with the number '2' – '1+1='
- Write your content – the big white box!
- Upload a cover picture (please make sure the width is no wider than 1920px and the size is no larger than 400mb!) – 'File(s) – Choose File'
- Choose a category – this is the topic your post relates to:
 - About my class
 - Citizenship
 - Discrimination
 - Freedom of association/assembly
 - Freedom of expression

- Freedom of religion
- Labour rights
- LGBTQI rights
- Media Freedom
- Migration
- Participation
- Privacy
- Roma rights
- Social rights
- And send it online - 'Submit this post'

Tips and tricks

- If you want to add pictures into the blog post – click on 'add media' and upload a picture
- If you want to embed a YouTube video – make sure it is on a separate line to the text of your post

Step 3

Check out what everyone else has posted!
